Bill Eigel: Let's go Missouri. Let's go St. Charles. Great to be back here in what is the largest Republican stronghold in the great state of Missouri. Everybody I know almost everybody in this room, but for those I haven't met I'm Bill I'm running to be the next Governor of the great state of Missouri.

Tonight, I want to make another intervention and shout out to my wife Amanda. She has been the rock behind me for my entire eight years in office.

A shout out to my father-in-law Dave's here. They stand up.

Thank you for calling today because I found as I found out on my wedding day, 23 years ago, he has a very big shotgun. What a great night's, what a great night. You know, many of y'all start off moving about me. For those that don't know me that so many of you already know that I'm an Air Force veteran. I served the United States Air when serving our country is actually something that's coming naturally to the single family. In fact, my wife Amanda is also an Air Force veteran.

Father was an Air Force veteran. My brother is an Air Force veteran. I actually have two uncles and one cousin who are Air Force veterans. I love one uncle and two cousins who are United States Army veterans. Army guys here. I also have a grandfather who was a US Army veteran. He was a cook in World War Two. I have a nephew. I have a young nephew right now who is deployed in Japan and is serving as a younger officer in the United States Marine Corps. In six weeks ago, my only son enlisted in the United States Navy.

Man for Christmas got a t shirt that says Navy dad. And I'm very proud of them. But hey, we came here to talk a little politics tonight. And I'll tell you what, since I spoke here, a year ago, I put 60,000 miles on my truck traveling all over the state meet Republicans in every town, in every county in this state. And they're all telling me the same thing. They're disappointed. They're frustrated, they're angry, when they do nothing super majority of Republicans that is letting Missouri fall behind you definitely. get real tired of seeing other bold conservatives lead other big red states to leadership in these United States. And they want to know when is it going to be our turn? Now it's our turn. Find yourself being one of those Republicans that are frustrated or angry, I want you to know you're not alone. There are millions of Republicans in this state right now that are going to stand up in 2024. And we're going to send a reckoning to Jefferson City. We're going to disrupt the powerful we're going to disrupt the elite view, just like Donald J. Trump is doing at the national level, we're going to have a reckoning right here in the state of Missouri. What's that revenue look like? It looks like the implementation of all the promises that

we've been making to the Republican electorate for two decades, now is the time we're going to make it actually happy to do it. What are those ideas because ideas ideas, they're just saying carved into the first story of the Missouri capitalist his ideas will rule the world. And when we get found out for the past two decades is that our ideas are Republicans are not wrong, even if sometimes our politicians are weak. And those ideas or the Missouri that I'm calling you to think about the misery that I am going to fight for on behalf of every one of the 6 million Missouri's that live in this state is a Missouri that's a leader in this country. And the first one of the first things we're going to do you have my commitment here tonight, folks, we're getting rid of personal property taxes.

It's amazing to me that I'm the only candidate for governor that supporting a plan to eliminate personal property taxes because I want to save you money. Yes, but more than that, you shouldn't have to pay rent for the drivability of the car in this day. And I'll tell you what else we're going to do. When it comes to the sale of our land to other states. We're going to put it stuck to it entire. Back in 2013, the legislature made a mistake, one of my opponents in his race actually voted to allow China or any other foreign country to buy up to 270,000 acres of our farmland. I want you to know that under an idle administration, we are never going to let that happen again. And we're going to get every square inch of the ground the last time from China or anybody else and put it back in American hands right here in the state of Missouri.

And what about the issue of our time illegal immigration, President Joe Biden has opened the border and allowed it invasion of our country, and invasion of our state that is taking our state sovereignty and leaving Missouri behind, which is why on the very first day on your governor, I'm going to declare an invasion under Article four of the Missouri Constitution. And we are going to empower them to share every National Guard member, every highway patrol then to implement my policy concerning illegal immigration, detained into ports.

We've got a lot of money down there and Jefferson City and I'm here to tell you right now, we're going to buy a fleet of buses. And if I have to drive the buses myself, we're going to get our communities back from the surge of illegal immigration, the Federal Trade and human trafficking trade that's coming out of our cities that have adopted soft on crime policy. Let's talk about our school. Yeah, the school the schools that have been doing terrible things in our COVID environment, teaching our children to hate one another, and teaching our children that we don't lead to determine their bedtime, that somehow, they can determine the gender that God Himself has ordained workbook and stop all of that nonsense. God, if you're wondering, how am I going to do it, I'm telling you, and you have my commitment here tonight, that on the first day, I'm going to sign an executive order that will eliminate every diversity, equity, inclusion areas, and all other nonsense DRT positions. And every college university, every State Department, and every school across this nation, we're going to start teaching kids reading, writing and arithmetic and.

A lot of great school board candidates here to build our schools, our public schools are being held back by one of the biggest most inefficient bureaucracies Jefferson City has ever seen. You

know what I'm talking about. I'm talking about the Department of Elementary and Secondary, which takes a bunch of money from Washington, DC, and a bunch of data that tells our local schools and they gotta teach. I want to tell you right now, not only we got to stop taking all that past Washington, DC, I'm gonna reform Deci. When I say reform, we got to funding that.

You know, I've been doing this for 18 months, 18 months, I've been traveling around this state. And I've met so many folks that are as interested in that Missouri, as you are here tonight. This misery that I've been talking about is opposed by a special interest, sewer user or a dark sewer down in Jefferson City that doesn't care about. But I tell you what, they are afraid of you more than you know. And they know that the moment that you stand up and choose something not that is the sewer, their rents and their days in a row. And so, they've been working XP for these past 18 months. They are desperate for you to be afraid. And they're telling you that a guy like me, I don't have enough lobbyist money to do it. I don't have enough data, my needs when I'm telling you tonight, go buy into that. Don't be afraid of that. The Swamp is desperate for you to be afraid. They're desperate for you to determine that is better off for you to sit down and not saying anything and go with the flow than to fight for your state. Well, guess what? They're already losing that battle at the national level with Donald J. Trump. This year, they're going to lose it in Jefferson City.

Now this is gonna be an easy fight, and I need to win. You know, I stood here eight years ago, asking for your trust to be your state senator. And all I promised you is that I would be in office who had promised to be a campaign. And I kept on that promise. And I'll tell you what, keeping that promise has made me one of the most wonderful Popular guys ever in deficit city. I don't want you to know I don't man. This year, this is our time to get that Missouri that the voters show up every other year on the second Tuesday in November, and demand from people in Jefferson City.
